## **Clinical Practice**

I trained in Yorkshire and after a vascular fellowship in Toronto was appointed to the post of Consultant Vascular Surgeon in Leeds in January 1994. I have a large NHS practice based at the Leeds General Infirmary and Wharfedale Hospital. I have extensive experience in the management of arterial and venous disease, including endovascular treatments and minimally invasive treatment of varicose veins and hyperhidrosis. I also see and treat patients with thoracic outlet syndrome and related conditions, renal failure requiring vascular access and peritoneal dialysis and vascular aspects of oncology.

I have wide experience in most aspects of general surgery, although from 1994 most of my caseload has been vascular in nature with some minor general surgical work. Since the Major Trauma Centre opened in the Leeds General Infirmary in April 2013 I have been a member of the Trauma Team and am responsible for the management of patients with vascular, abdominal and thoracic trauma.

I work closely with colleagues in interventional radiology, and offer minimally invasive approaches to arterial and venous disease, with access to state of the art imaging facilities thus providing a complete surgical and endovascular service.

## **Medico-legal Experience**

I have a busy Medico-legal practice, and accept instructions for reports on complications of arterial and venous surgery; thromboembolism; soft-tissue injuries resulting in vascular complications; reports on orthopaedic trauma with vascular complications; and reports on DVT / PE.
