PROFESSIONAL PROFILE

I am a Consultant Orthopaedic Surgeon at Leighton Hospital, Crewe with an interest in upper limb injuries. I have worked as a consultant since July 2010. I work as a trauma surgeon in a busy trauma department. I undertake regular fracture clinics and regular on call duty. My trauma work covers a wide range of musculoskeletal injuries including upper and lower limb injuries as well as spinal trauma. My elective work covers upper limb conditions including open and arthroscopic shoulder surgery, hand surgery, shoulder replacements.

I undertook my undergraduate training at Edinburgh University and qualified in 1999. My basic surgical training was in the West Midlands and I obtained my fellowship to the Royal College of Surgeons in 2002. I undertook my higher surgical training from 2004 to 2010 on the Oswestry, Stoke-on-Trent rotation. I obtained my specialist fellowship of Trauma and Orthopaedics in 2008. I undertook a Fellowship in Australia in 2010 in shoulder, elbow and hand surgery.

MEDICOLEGAL EXPERIENCE

I have been performing medicolegal personal injury and complex cases since 2011. Currently, I do personal injury reports and not negligence cases. I undertake approximately 250 cases a year.
