**PROFESSIONAL PROFILE**

I am a Consultant Orthopaedic Surgeon at Leighton Hospital, Crewe with an interest in upper limb injuries. I have worked as a consultant since July 2010. I work as a trauma surgeon in a busy trauma department. I undertake regular fracture clinics and regular on call duty. My trauma work covers a wide range of musculoskeletal injuries including upper and lower limb injuries as well as spinal trauma. My elective work covers upper limb conditions including shoulder, elbow, hand and wrist surgery.

I undertook my undergraduate training at Edinburgh University and qualified in 1999. My basic surgical training was in the West Midlands and I obtained my fellowship to the Royal College of Surgeons in 2002. I undertook my higher surgical training from 2004 to 2010 on the Oswestry, Stoke-on-Trent rotation. I obtained my Certificate of Completion of Training (CCT) in 2010 after successfully passing the FRCS Orth exam in Trauma and Orthopaedics in 2008. I undertook a Fellowship in Australia in 2010 in shoulder, elbow and hand surgery.

**MEDICOLEGAL EXPERIENCE**

I have been performing medicolegal work since 2011. I undertake approximately 300 personal injury cases a year. I also perform medical negligence work. I have kept up to date with the Medco training (2016) and two day medicolegal writing and courtroom skills Bond Solon course (2017) and attended medicolegal conferences (2019). I have also kept my knowledge up to date with attending the annual British Elbow Shoulder Society meetings and British Orthopaedic Association annual meetings. My defendant to claimant ratio is in the order of 60% for the claimant for independent instructions and more complex cases but for agency work the majority is for the claimant.
