Mrs. Victoria Jenkins is a Forensic Science Consultant specialising in the areas of Forensic Pharmacology & Toxicology, and has worked as an independent Consultant since 1997.

Whilst gaining a BSc.(Hons.) in Pharmacology and Toxicology at the School of Pharmacy, University of London, Victoria worked at Glaxo Research and Development assisting with drug trials. She then gained further experience on the Hospital Contracts Team at PPP Healthcare.

From 1997 - 1999, Victoria specialised further, becoming a trainee scientist in the field of Forensic Toxicology. During this time she underwent detailed training in vital laboratory skills, attended the Department of Forensic Medicine and Science in Glasgow to further her knowledge, and, to strengthen her expertise, attended additional courses in the written and oral presentation of forensic evidence.

From 1999 - 2002, Victoria was Head of the Drug and Toxicology Department at Formedeccon Ltd., and during her time there obtained the additional qualifications of Chartered Biologist and Member of the Institute of Biology. Victoria also underwent training in the use of the 'Camic Datamaster' and 'Lion Intoxilyzer 6000UK' breath testing machines.

Victoria's extensive experience includes the detailed examination of evidence and the production of written reports relating to:

- Drink-driving offences, including alcohol back-calculations and technical defences;
- Driving whilst unfit through drugs;
- Drug effects and interactions;
- Effects of alcohol at different levels;
- Effects and interactions of medications;
- Toxicological aspects in a whole scope of cases, including criminal cases (ranging from drink-driving offences to assaults, rapes and murders), insurance matters and medical negligence issues.
