I am currently an Honorary Consultant General Adult and Liaison Psychiatrist and Clinical Lecturer at Barts and The London School of Medicine and Dentistry. My principle interests lie in general adult psychiatry, neuropsychiatry and liaison psychiatry. My CCT is in general adult and liaison psychiatry. I have extensive clinical, management and educational experience, including in tutoring and teaching on a number of university and NHS Trust courses. My current research involves the investigation of the neurophysiology of chronic idiopathic pain using a specialised neuroimaging method.
