Medico Legal Background

I am an Ear Nose and Throat Surgeon with twenty five years experience working at the Consultant grade as a surgeon at Ashford St Peter's NHS Trust and the Royal Surrey County Hospital in Guildford, two of the acute hospitals in the Surrey Heartlands STP. In this role I have held both clinical and senior managerial roles.

Throughout this time, I have also worked at the BMI Runnymede as a private practitioner in ENT surgery, basing my practice and secretary here. I have also worked at other private hospitals including BMI Princess Margaret Hospital, Woking and Guildford Nuffield Hospitals, and Ramsay Ashtead Hospital. I have been the National Lead for Outpatient Transformation for the Get It Right First Time program, part of NHS England

I possess formal qualifications in medicine, management and law. I am a broadly trained ENT surgeon and my main clinical interests lie in nasal surgery and particularly endoscopic sinus surgery, balloon sinuplasty and benign head and neck surgery. Paediatric ENT surgery constitutes a significant part of my practice.

I have practiced as a medico legal expert for about twenty five years. Since 2010, I have been available to advise on medical negligence relevant to my areas of clinical expertise and have declined a number of instructions where I do not feel my expertise is relevant. I generally produce one to two medico legal reports per week. These are mostly instructions for Claimants seeking redress for injuries and noise induced hearing loss – 90% of instructions. Approximately one in ten of instructions are from a defendant – 10% on instructions. I have worked as a single joint expert and with other experts to produce a joint report and attended conferences with Counsel. I have appeared in Court as an Expert Witness on two occasions.

I have a longstanding interest in the law and its application within medicine. I changed from medicine to law for my Part II at Cambridge University, qualifying in all six subjects necessary at that time to practice law (1980). After qualifying in medicine from Oxford University (1983) and completing house posts, I was offered a Harmsworth Exhibition to the Middle Temple to train as a Barrister. I was obliged to turn down this opportunity for personal reasons but continued training in medicine. I have nevertheless maintained an interest in law, developing a medico legal practice as a Consultant and completing the Bond Solon Expert Witness Diploma through Cardiff University. I maintain a wider interest in medico legal issues, and particularly of late, the application of gross negligence manslaughter in the medical environment (notably

the Cases of Hadiza Bawa Garba and Mr David Sellu) and changes in the law of consent after the case of Montogmery v Lanarkshire Health Authority. I maintain continuous professional development in medico legal issues. I have recently attended conferences organized by Inspire Medical Law (December 2020 and December 2023) and Bond Solon (November 2021).

I see clients face to face in my Consulting rooms in Surrey, usually the Runnymede Hospital. I can usually offer appointments within one to two weeks if required. I am also happy to offer remote appointments either by telephone or video consultation, although it might be necessary to undertake hearing tests through a separate arrangement.
