I have been a Consultant Plastic Surgeon since 1996 and have a broad experience having worked in the Army, the NHS, and the private sector, in the UK and in several other countries.

I have interests in burns, trauma, scars, and cosmetic/aesthetic surgery of the breast and trunk.

I have over 20 years of experience writing reports and receive about 400 instructions per year (Claimant, Defendant and Joint).

I am aware of the requirements of Part 35 and Practice Direction 35, the Protocol for the Instruction of Experts to Give Evidence in Civil Claims and the practice direction on pre-action conduct and I have obtained Part 1 of the Certificate of Medical Reporting (the Bond Solon Civil Procedure Rules Expert Witness Certificate) to evidence my understanding and compliance of the above requirements.

I regularly attend medico-legal training and updates, most recently the Bond Solon Annual Expert Witness Conference, 3 November 2023.

I am happy to take on medical negligence cases if they fall within my areas of expertise.
