Experience

Since completing junior doctor training I have gained almost 10 years of ENT experience. I have been fortunate that this has predominantly been in larger units covering all of the subspecialties in ENT. After

foundation training I was the senior anatomy demonstrator at the University of Newcastle which has given me an excellent grounding in anatomy and physiology for a career in surgery.

I have had very good opportunities in the area of rhinology and have worked in the Edinburgh, Dundee and Liverpool departments under the guidance of very experienced rhinologists. I have been exposed to advanced FESS surgery and skull base pituitary work as well as rhinoplasty and facial plastics. I feel the East of Scotland rotation is well balanced and I am confident in my Otolaryngology and Head and Neck skills as well as being able to manage emergency patients and the surgical procedures associated with them. I have completed an advanced Rhinology fellowship in Aintree which has exposed me to a number of different surgical conditions and procedures. The fellowship has improved my research and surgical skills and is approved by the Royal College of Surgeons.

Throughout my career I have worked in multidisciplinary teams and as an otolaryngologist trainee I have benefited from working closely with a number of different specialties including, ophthalmology, maxillo-facial surgery, plastic surgery, and neurosurgery. I enjoy working with and have constantly demonstrated the ability to build good relationships with allied specialties such as audiology, radiology, oncology and speech and language therapy.

I have a keen interest in education having gained a postgraduate certificate in education from the University of Newcastle in 2010. I have since set up a mentoring scheme on the East of Scotland to help those junior doctors/medical students who have an interest in ENT. I also help run a charity (Prepared4ENT) that runs interview courses and introduction courses to ENT in the North East of England and the East of Scotland.

I have worked for over three years now as a consultant and been actively involved in the COVID effort in Tayside as well as performing urgent and emergency work. I am involved in the Shared Airway, Cancer and HHT MDTs. I am the site lead for the MACRO research trial and I am a digital champion helping NHS Tayside in its goal to become a digital leader.

Clinical Governance

I have regularly attended and presented at local clinical governance meetings. I help the junior doctors get started with their own projects and supervise as needed.

I have being actively involved in the department and trusts plans for COVID 19. I have been in charge of creating the COVID 19 WHO checklist for theatres and also the Trust tracheostomy protocols.

I have kept an up to date logbook of all the operations I have assisted and performed in. I have performed regular reflection on my surgical practise with supervisors and carried out a tonsillectomy self audit on primary and secondary haemorrhage rates. During my fellowship I have carried out a septoplasty audit on my technique and PROMs. I have also performed a self-audit on the skin cancers excisions I have performed and compared to the BADS guidance on positive margins.

Management

I am the lead for the HHT service in Tayside and we are looking to get a central contract regarding this role. We are aiming to be recognised as a centre for excellence via the cure HHT group. We have set up a PAVM service and arranged paediatric screening in NHS Scotland.

I was the British Rhinological Society Juniors president 2020. This is a new role set up to lead a committee in a number of tasks to try and improve the access for trainees and students to rhinological training, fellowships and increase the number of junior members to the BRS. We have created a comprehensive website <https://sites.google.com/view/brsjuniors/home> that has a research section as well as fellowship and training sections. I have helped to run the first free BRSJ meeting last year in Glasgow for 100 trainees with excellent feedback and we have another planned this year in Sheffield. The BRSJ have also just taken on the role to review the current local anaesthetic evidence for rhinological procedures to help the main BRS committee create a consensus statement on this topic.

For 6 years I organised and managed the ST3 interview course in Edinburgh. I have recruited some fellow registrars to help but my role is to oversee the whole event and organise the faculty and delegates as well as the actress and the monetary side of the course. The course each year donates any profit made to charity.

Personal Achievements

Whilst at University I played for the Great British American Football team. I captained the University American Football team and represented the Northern All Stars for four years.

I sing and play the guitar in a band, we've have had three CDs of my own music produced and released to the public, and toured around the country playing venues from Glasgow to London including the Cavern in

Liverpool. We have been involved in a lot of charity work over a number of years totalling 9 gigs and raising around £5000 for a variety of charities from Children In Need to the Great North Children's Hospital.

Currently I really enjoy cycling and running and have started competing in triathlons with and aim to perform a half Iron Man next year.

Quality Improvement

- I have created head and neck flow charts for the emergency clinic in Dundee to try and improve the quality of patient investigation and management in the head and neck cases following an audit into breaches of the cancer pathways.
- I have helped to run 3 patient support days. The first was an anosmia day with the charity 5th Sense. The second two are with patients with HHT. The idea behind these is the help create a support group for these patients and also a centre of excellence for HHT in Dundee.
