I am a fully certified Consultant Trauma and Orthopaedic Surgeon in Oxford, UK, working in the Tertiary Centre in Oxford at the Oxford University Hospitals NHS Trust, which is also one of the NHSE Sarcoma Centres. I am on the specialist registers of the medical councils of the UK (GMC) and EU (MMC Malta). I completed subspecialist fellowship training in the UK, Canada and Switzerland in my areas of subspecialisation. My areas of expertise are Paediatric Trauma and Orthopaedics, Hip Dysplasia and Hip Preservation, Neuromuscular Orthopaedics (including CP), Post-Traumatic Limb Reconstruction and Bone Infection Surgery, and Sarcoma
